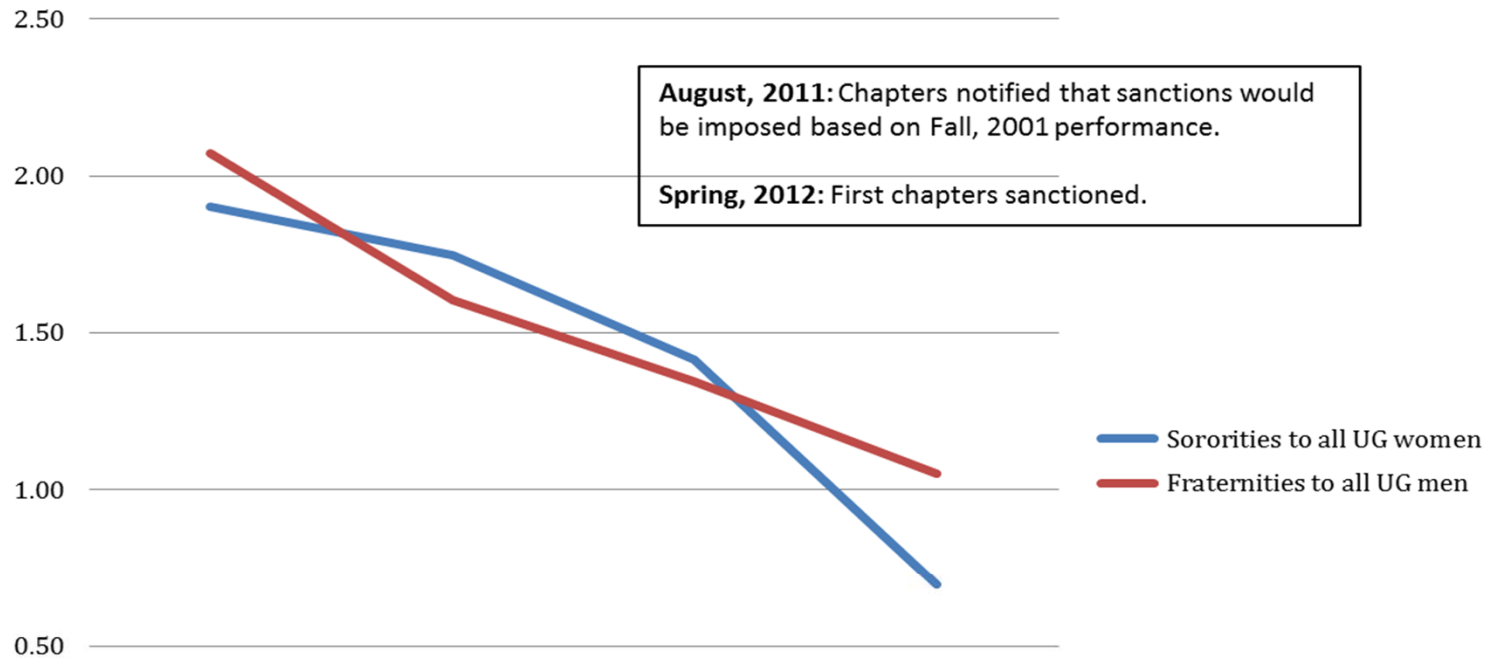
Updates include:

Arrest & Citation Policy

Please share your chapter's A & C reports with the appropriate alumni and national volunteers/HQ staff.

We will be updating our "Gold Cards*" to reflect that the University can directly share this information with National Volunteers/HQ staff.

All A & C appeals have been submitted and responses back to the chapters who appealed.



*Gold Cards are what new members complete in order to be added to a chapter's roster. It is the academic release of information for the chapter.

Registered Events

All IFC and PHC event registration is now online, via an OrgSync form available on the chapter's OrgSync page.

Once a Chapter Social Chair has submitted a form, Chapter Advisors will be sent an approval request via email and need to click on the link in the email to approve the event.

Once the information has been approved by IFC/PHC, it will be added to the weekly event memo.



Sober Monitors at Events with Alcohol

- IFC & PHC policy requires five (5) sober monitors at events with alcohol.
- These should be undergraduate peer monitors.
- Alumni are always encouraged to attend these events, but should not replace the 5 peer sober monitors



Emergency Procedures

- At the FSL Leadership Advance, we provide every chapter president a one-page flow chart for them to fill out of contact names and numbers in case of an emergency, as well as a narrative.
- Our narrative now included information about Sexual Assault.
- Copy of both have been sent to all advisors prior to this call.



Emergency Procedures

- Many of these services are “time-sensitive” so going to the hospital as soon as possible after a sexual assault is best. After 4-5 days, options are limited.
- All of the hospital services, including medications, are provided at NO charge through a state program that pays for services for rape victims.
- The victim has the RIGHT to report or not report; to participate in services offered or NOT.



Greek Energy Challenge

- The goal is for chapters with houses to reduce energy usage and electric bills.
- Competition will take place for 4 weeks in April – start and ending date will depend on a chapters billing cycle
- Let me know by Friday, March 1 if you want to participate.



Greek Energy Challenge

The competition is simple:

- Each chapter house/structure that wishes to participate utilizes strategies for energy reduction (ex: unplugging electronics, turning off lights, etc.).
- For one month, in this case, April, we will compare the chapter's energy bill from this year 2013, to last year's energy bill in 2012.
- The chapter house/structure with the greatest percent decrease between the two bills is awarded a prize from the University of Iowa Student Government (UISG).



Greek Energy Challenge

If you are interested in participating, you have two options to providing your billing information:

Option #1: If you have access to a hardcopy of your bills and if you can find the meter read dates, you can send the Energy Challenge Team an email with your meter read dates.

Option #2: If you don't have access to a hardcopy, but you can access your account online, you will be able to access a PDF of your actual bill online. You can also access a summary of your usage history which also includes the meter read dates.
